




Welcome to The Mint Museum!



The Mint Museum Tour Information



Tours at the Mint provide immersive experiences for visitors of all ages, whether guided by knowledgeable docents at Mint Museum Uptown and Mint Museum Randolph, or self-guided to explore at your own pace. These experiences deepen connections with art and enhance visual literacy, offering enriching insights into the museum collections.

Guided Tours

Led by knowledgeable Mint Docents, guided tours are available throughout the year. The tours are designed for groups of at least 10 and up to 60 participants. Each tour lasts approximately 60 minutes. To ensure availability, guided tours should be scheduled at least 30 days in advance. Guided tours or special exhibitions are available upon request.

Self-Guided Tours

Experience the museum at your own pace with flexible, self-guided tours. Accommodating groups of at least 10 and up to 60 participants, self-guided tours should be scheduled at least 15 days in advance.


Timing
